Minutes from the meeting held on 7th November 2019

1. **Apologies for Absence**

3. **Public Session**

4. To consider the Parish Council responses in respect of the following planning applications: -

a) 2019/2408/HSE – Proposed two storey rear extension, infill on existing porch and re-siting of front door, Glenmead, Stoke Hill, Stoke St Michael

After a short discussion and noting that it was a large extension but was not excessive in relation to neighbouring properties, it was proposed by Cllr McEntee to recommend approval on the ground that it didn't cause harm to other properties, this was seconded by Cllr Hambly and unanimously agreed.

b) 2019/2125/FUL – Erection of farm workshop and storage building – retrospective. Stoke Bottom Track between Harridge Wood and Giddy Lane, Stratton on the Fosse.

After some discussion it was proposed by Cllr Wolf and seconded by Cllr McEntee that the Parish Council recommend refusal of permission. This was because it was felt that it was not in keeping with the agricultural context based on the materials alone, wooden cladding would be more appropriate instead of the metal installed. There were also insufficient drawings to make a judgement on the storage building / hay machine store as opposed to the workshop. This was unanimously agreed.

c) 2019/2537/FUL – Improved access to agricultural land (retrospective). Land at Limekiln Lane, Stoke St Michael.

Cllr Wolf proposed that the Parish Council recommend approval due to having no grounds for refusal, this was seconded by Cllr Corbett and unanimously agreed.
