"To resolve..."</p>	<p>To consider the purchase of a water butt to be installed at the church for use in the churchyard</p>
<p>Background Information: Insert as much information as possible so that councillors have the detail that they need in order to make an informed decisions</p>	<p>Water in the churchyard is currently provided by an outside tap running from the church's own water supply.</p> <p>There is suspicion that this tap may be getting left on or is leaking. The Parochial Church Council have proposed that the tap is disconnected and replaced with a water butt, providing a cheaper and more environmentally friendly solution.</p> <p>Costs for various sizes of water butt (150L – 250L) with stand and diverter have been obtained and range from £62.94 to £98.75. Installation is straightforward and would be carried out by a member of the church, however permission will be required from the Diocese before the work can proceed.</p> <p>As maintenance of the churchyard is the responsibility of the Parish Council, it would seem reasonable that the costs are covered by the PC.</p>
