<p>Background Documents: Insert names of documents to be sent out with the meeting papers.</p>	<p>“Leigh on Mendip have five dog bins dotted around the village, yet we have none on the south of the village. Given the number of dwellings on Mendip Road, many of which have been built in the last two years to 18 years, there is more traffic on this route, and this is only going to increase as the new Cookswood development explore the surroundings. This is also Stoke St Michael's only direct route to Cranmore Tower, so many use it for access there or onwards to the East Mendip Way. The Cranmore Tower is also bidding for national lottery funding, so development there is likely to attract yet more traffic to this route.</p> <p>As one dog walker amongst many on these routes, it would be great if adequate facilities could be provided to protect the surrounding countryside.”</p>
<p>Costs: Insert detail of any costs associated with the decision that you are asking the council to make</p>	<p>A new dog waste bin would need to be purchased from Glasdon which is the preferred supplier of Mendip District Council, prices start at £100 + VAT, this is just for the bin, a pole would also need to be purchased.</p> <p>If the site is located on private land, permission form the landowner would need to be obtained. If the land belongs to Somerset County Council a permit would need to be obtained for an approximate cost of £250.00</p>
