We did continue to maintain the field and the play areas all year. This is an expensive business and the repairs that Somerset Playing field association have highlighted are not all in place. We have set up a "blooms for bees" zone around part of the perimeter of the field. This is a village wide scheme encouraged by Natural England and lead in Stoke, by Simon Clarke.

Major work was carried out on the half pipe with funding from Cookswood quarry. John Wainwright's quarries have supported our plan to set up soccer for fun for youngsters in the village with further generous support. This is a summer scheme to get Sunday games back on the field with boys and girls of all ages out to play.
