FINACIALS

- Stable position
- Enough reserves enough to cover predictable overheads.
- Trying to keep hire costs down to be competitive but obviously overheads increasing YoY.
- Will ideally need extra funding to assist the major facilities repairs and upgrades needed.
- Reliant on volunteers to 'staff' events and to 'caretake' the hall
